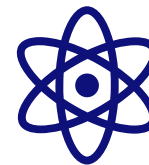

Salary: This industry has a very **competitive wage**. According to the [Bureau of Labor Statistics](#) Funeral Service workers' median annual wage as of 2020 is \$58,170 and a Funeral Home Manager's median annual wage is \$74,200.

High Demand: As of 2020 Funeral Directors are considered **essential workers**. According to the [Bureau of Labor Statics](#) as of 2019 there were 55,200 jobs in Funeral Service. They are at a higher demand now than ever before. The industry itself is ever-changing and evolving. This gives students the opportunities they wish to seek.

CAREER IN FUNERAL SERVICE

Funeral Director: “a licensed professional that takes care of a dead body through the embalming, burial or cremation process, as well as the arrangements for the funeral ceremony.”

Specific Career Titles:

- **Funeral Director**
Oversees all aspects of a funeral home operation. Many funeral directors own their own funeral homes while others work in corporate-owned facilities or conglomerates.
- **Embalmer**
Provides embalming services to funeral homes. Some embalmers work for individual funeral homes, while others offer independent services to funeral home clients.
- **Armed Services Funeral Services**
Branches of the military employ funeral services professionals to serve in the preparation of fallen service members.
- **Pathology Technician**
Prepares specimens for examination by a physician in hospital and morgue labs.
- **Medical Center Specialist**
Prepares remains of those who have donated their bodies to medical science or education.
- **Funeral Supply Sales**
Many funeral supply providers require sales personnel to hold a professional funeral service license. Funeral supplies sold may include chemicals, caskets, limos & hearses, clothes, and instruments.
- **Ceremonialist**
Helps the bereaved plan the celebration of the life for the departed.
- **Crematory Technician**
Prepares human remains for cremation, cremates the remains and arranges for disposal of the cremated remains.
